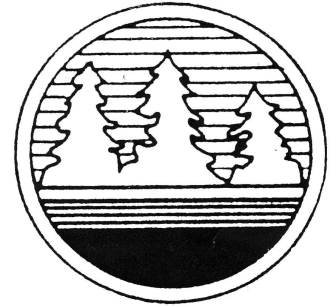

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## President's Message

Friday, March 31, 2017 - Letter from Jason Battles, LMCPC President

Dear Lake Margaret community: within this newsletter I wanted to include a brief update on the LMCPC water system and its operations. We are beginning a new fiscal year starting this April and are currently developing the budget to implement upcoming projects, perform necessary maintenance and conserve for planned future projects.

Joe Connell, our Water Chair, has submitted a grant request to the WA Department of Health for \$30,000 to investigate the following items:

- Repair or replace the ozone unit
- Determine the cause and potential solutions for excess manganese in the roughing filters
- The best method for corrosion control treatment including pH adjustment
- Replacement of the water storage tank.

Engineering, design and construction are also included in the grant proposal, allowing us to allocate those funds towards our most immediate projects as we see fit. These projects will be implemented to enhance the redundancy in, and operational effectiveness of, our water treatment system, especially in regards to maintaining the desired pH level. We will resolve our treatment technique violation (TTV) while making our system more reliable and easier to maintain. We have much work to do and your participation as a member of this community is appreciated and always welcome.

**OPENING DAY FISHING SEASON** is Saturday, April 22nd and we will have a King County officer on duty the night before to make certain everyone behaves themselves. A Fish & Game warden will likely be present during the day checking licenses. There is absolutely no fishing allowed in the swim lot area or anywhere east of the dam tower.



**Saturday, April 29th** will be our first of several work parties & community clean up days of 2017. The items we want to address this year are: applying preservative to the logs at the shelter and a second coat to the picnic tables, weed-whacking the dam face, building a pony wall and steps at the picnic shelter, planting bushes & trees, mowing the swim lot and the well lot, weed-whacking a path to the private fishing lot on 436th, removing debris from the out-flow, and applying fresh paint at the reader board sign.

Volunteers will be treated to FREE sandwiches, sodas and cookies afterward, and this work counts towards service hours for school credits.
